However, due to many complications, we were unable to get our work permits. Thus, we've had to return to the USA to get business visas.



This week we are having a vacation at the Snows Mill Guest house which provides free accommodation for missionaries. Praise the Lord with us for His provision. We will be returning to Ethiopia next week to continue our term of service.

Recently, we have been involved in various types of building. Becky has been in charge of building this new Guest House office (at right). Of course, the nitty gritty building matters are all supervised by a building contractor. But, Becky is in charge of him. The new office should be completed when we return next week.



The building of the new Ethiopia Kale Heywet (Word of Life) Ministry Training College campus in

Hosanna started in May. The actual building details are supervised by a building contractor, but Harold is on the building committee and distributes the funds. This first building (above) is due for completion January 2004. Pray that funds will continue to come in so that the entire campus can be built without interruption. Another project that Harold oversees is Amharic Bible School Construction. In the last two years, it has been subsidizing the building of eight new buildings. At the right is the new Amharic Bible School building in Alaba, an area that is 95% Muslim.

From June through August, Harold attended graduations at six different schools. Pray for all the graduates as they minister in building God's church in Ethiopia.

over \$100,000 US to meet the basic Theological Education scholarship needs for over 300 students for the 2003-2004 school year. On a more personal note, we are looking forward to Faith and Rodney, our younger daughter and her husband, visiting us later this month and staying for several months. Rodney will be helping in building and Faith will be helping Becky at the Guest House. We are especially thrilled that their first child will be born in Ethiopia the end of December. Pray that we will have a great time together. Pray that all will go well with the birth of the baby.
